Singer/songwriter Chelsea Berry returns to New Haven's Trinity Church

NEW HAVEN, Conn. (January 25, 2018) — Singer/songwriter **Chelsea Berry** returns to historic Trinity Church on the Green for an encore performance at 7:30 p.m., March 3rd at the church, 230 Temple Street (corner Chapel and Temple), New Haven.

Possessing a voice of “remarkable power and control with a joyous soul” (Livingston Taylor), Berry will reprise her bravura 2016 Trinity performance as part of the Music4Music concert series, which helps to support the church’s nationally renowned music program led by Music Director **R. Walden Moore**.

A native Alaskan who studied classical music and opera at Boston’s Berklee School of Music, Berry has opened for performers including Chris Isaaks, Chris Smither and Marshall Crenshaw. Her most recent album, *Wanderbird*, produced by Adam Rhodes, was released in September.

Berry will perform a portion of the program with the **Trinity Girls Choir**, a professional choral ensemble of young women from grades four through high school from throughout southern Connecticut selected by audition. Berry will also lead a workshop with the girls on the afternoon of the performance (not open to the public).
