- Luk opened the meeting by welcoming committee members and stating that Trinity Church owes its success to all of the hard-working committees that help each of us build a home with God and with each other. The summer planning meetings for all six ministries are designed to bring us together and facilitate communication, to plan future work to foster this success, to reach more people beyond our Trinity community, and to build continued engagement with one another.

 - Facebook is an excellent tool, as well. Ellen Freiler manages Facebook; as meetings and events are planned, be sure to send her the information.
 - We need to provide a clear picture of the ministry budget for 2018. All committee chairs are invited to the October Vestry meeting, where this information will be shared; the date is Monday, October 16, 2017 at 5:30 in our Undercroft. Leaders of the individual committees are asked to be present; all are welcome.
 - There will be a meeting of all interested members of this ministry Saturday, September 16th at 12:00 pm in the Undercroft to discuss 2018 calendar and budget.
 - In 2015 members of the Vestry created a Vestry Covenant listing twelve tenants that guide all meetings and interactions. Luk shared our Vestry Covenant with the Music and the Arts Ministry this evening, hoping it becomes a covenant to guide the life of our parish.
